



LOVING RELATIONSHIPS

Jesus replied, "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: Love your neighbor as yourself." ~ Matthew 22:37-39

WORLDLY PROGRAMING

Humans come into this world as unique individuals with their own likes, talents and personalities. Then they get mostly subjective direction (both good and bad) from authority figures and worldly systems. This information combines with their own distinctive processing to create beliefs, values, habits, social skills, relationship guidelines, etc. but most importantly how to love (or not). Adults create problems when choices are based on their unconscious desire to seek out unhappy familiar relationship patterns learned from childhood and so continue the generational misery. When people conform to others in this sick world, they do not learn how to really love and unloving behavior becomes the norm.

HIGHER STANDARD

The Loving Creator Father commands all His children to love at a higher standard than what the world requires. While the worldly definition of love varies with society, culture and family, it usually swings from affection to anger based on expectations. The world has no uniform standard for love, but God does. He wants all humans to be Christ like, which is impossible to achieve without His supernatural support. In Matthew 5:44-45 of the Bible, Christ Jesus says to love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, that you may be sons of your Father in heaven. Apostle Paul defines love specifically in 1 Corinthians 13:4-6 as patient, kind, not envious, not boastful, not proud, not rude, not self-seeking, not easily angered, not record keepers of wrongs, haters of evil, celebrators in the truth, always protecting, always trusting, always hoping and always persevering.

HOLY SUPPORT

Holy Father God's divine supernatural love and support is far beyond human comprehension, but all people can know Him when they sincerely seek Him. The loving gifts God gives humans are vast and all He wants is love and

obedience, so His children can spiritually grow and return. However, bad worldly programming, ongoing anger, unforgiving, selfishness, hatred, etc. can block this holy spiritual bond and open a person up to evil influence. God listens and directs all of His creation but, sadly, few humans listen to Him. To return God's love, followers must not only believe in Jesus Christ and repent but also listen with contemplative prayer to discern His small quiet voice for guidance.

CHOOSE CHRIST JESUS

The Creator God had a plan for human salvation from the beginning, His Son Christ Jesus. In John 3:16 of the Bible, Jesus explained that God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. Since His Son Jesus Christ came as humanity's savior and role model, people really need to believe, accept and follow Jesus to fulfill their spiritual mission of loving beings. A relationship with Jesus gives Christians the Holy Spirit for supernatural joy, advice, comfort, love, strength, peace and guidance to do great things. When believers truly follow Christ, they will become obvious, fearless ambassadors of love and stand apart from this world. Become a loving role model to this sinful world by asking Jesus into your heart or to fill you more.

LOVING ROLE MODEL

Did and/or do you have a loving relationship with your mother and father by God's standards? If the answer is no, then you must let go of the past or you will pass on this worldly love to others. Begin with yourself and use God's love standards as defined by Apostle Paul in 1 Corinthians 13:4-6. Treat yourself with patience, kindness, acceptance, calmness, compassion, humility, generosity, respect, forgiveness and complements. Be discerning of thoughts so you can reject evil and recognize truth for protection, building trust, faithful hoping and perseverance. Change the one person you have control over, yourself. Loving Christians must be able to manage their emotions, socialize appropriately, have realistic thinking, live God's values, be self controlled, etc. Now share this holy love with others, so they ask about the joy in your heart.

LOVING OTHERS

Loving ambassadors of Christ show acceptance, forgiveness and love to all others by their willingness to discuss any subject and kindly addressing inappropriate behavior with suitable consequences minus insults or violence. People are more important than performance, power, status, money or

things, so build their self-esteem by respecting them as individuals and supporting their talents from God. Believers need to share their beliefs, give their testimonies and teach God's Word. They need loving communication skills with clear speech, focused listening, appropriate responses, an interest in others and acceptance of differences. God creates humans as unique, independent thinkers and does not want them conforming to this world.

Be In Christ's Family

- 1) Every human in this intelligently designed world comes with a divine plan but needs his or her Loving Creator to fulfill it.
- 2) For absolute truth, people need to know the Father, receive Christ Jesus, accept the Holy Spirit and read the Bible to learn about holy love.
- 3) Humans need to sincerely pray for God's guidance with a clear, receptive mind to hear His 24/7 advice. If prayers are not answered, more worship, adoration, gratefulness, repentance and obedience could be required.
- 4) God gives people what they need, not necessarily what they want, so learn from the lack and pain because these insights can lead to spiritual growth. If miracles, spiritual growth and a divine plan are not part of life, then a closer relationship with the Lord is absolutely necessary.
- 5) Believers need to accept that God created this world with supernatural love, so be curious and kind, not critical and blaming. The more repetitious negative emotions and worldly thinking used as a frame of reference, the more difficult it will be to have a close personal relationship with the Lord.
- 6) Since humans behave how they believe, fearless love is obvious and tranquil so find Christ's ambassadors. Life is service for others through Christ in love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faith, gentleness and self control.
